Treasurer John Shackelford, District 4

Mr. Shackelford was elected on November 4, 2008 and sworn in at the November 17, 2008 Board meeting. He was also elected Board Treasurer on November 17, 2008.

John H. Shackelford is a native of Pittsburg, PA. He entered the Air Force as a teenager in October 1952, attended Basic Training in Schenectady, New York and completed Advanced Individual Training for Supply Specialist at Cheyenne Air Force Base, Wyoming. In 1973, after twenty one years of active military service he retired as a veteran of the Vietnam War.

Mr. Shackelford has completed two years of College at Angeles City University in the Philippines. His military education includes the Airmen NCO Academy in South Dakota. As the President of the local chapter for the NAACP in Rapid City, South Dakota, Mr. Shackelford fought for the civil rights of American citizens in the 1960s. Supply Manager, responsible for daily supply and maintenance operations to include oversight of the supply and maintenance annual operating budget while assigned to Ankara Turkey.

In addition to his current Board position, Mr. Shackelford continues to serve as a Supply Manager for the Army Residence Community, responsible for the requisition and purchase of equipment and supplies for all homes and apartments on the property.
