Lesley Wenger was raised in Mexico City and graduated from the American School Foundation. She received her B.A. from New York University and has been employed in the visual arts field as a gallery director, curator, magazine editor and writer. Moving from California to San Antonio in 1996, Lesley began attending BexarMet Board meetings in 2000. In 2003 she became one of the founders and the Treasurer of the Committee to Reduce Water Rates.
