Hugo Enrique DeLeon is the Water Quality Manager at Bexar Metropolitan Water District (BexarMet). He began at BexarMet in September of 2004 as a Water Quality/Fluoride Technician. He manages the daily work assignments of 10 water quality technicians responsible for monitoring the water quality being supplied to customers in 21 Public Water Systems.

Mr. DeLeon retired from the U.S. Navy in June 2004 after serving 20 years of active duty. He served as a Boiler Technician for his first 12 years and then changed his rating to a Gas Turbine Systems Technician (Mechanical) for his remaining eight years. Both ratings specialized in the operation, maintenance, and troubleshooting of Propulsion Steam Generation plants, Propulsion Gas Turbine Engine Plants and all associated auxiliary equipment.
