Gov. Perry Appoints Harris to Bexar Metropolitan Water District Oversight Committee

AUSTIN – Gov. Rick Perry has appointed Rhonda Harris of Dallas to the Bexar Metropolitan Water District Oversight Committee for a term to expire at the pleasure of the governor. The committee will monitor the districts' progress on water conservation rate structure, quality of service, service to low-income customers and creating uniform rates among the water utility providers in the region. The committee will report its findings and make recommendations to the Texas Legislature's Natural Resources Committee.

Harris is a registered professional engineer and licensed "A" water/wastewater operator, and president and owner of PRO-OPS Inc. She is a member of the International Water Academy, exhibits chair for the Texas Water Conference, a committee chair for the Texas Chapter of the American Water Works Association and an honorary member of the American Water Works Association. She is also past president of the Water Environment Federation, and past president and former director of the Water Environment Association of Texas. Harris received a bachelor's degree from the University of Texas at Arlington and a Master of Business Administration from Southern Methodist University.
